In order to participate in the program:

- A referral form, immunization record, and a 1181 emergency contact sheet must be on file with the facility
- Sign ups must be completed with the Child Development Center or Youth Center on each Monday of the week the program is scheduled
- Children 6 weeks to 4 1/2 yrs of age are cared for at the Child Development Center. Children from 5 – 13 are cared for at the Youth Center. Contact the respective facility for care. Child Development Center; 606-1555 and the Youth Center; 606-2152.

The Give Parents a Break program will not be held unless there are eight (8) children registered by the sign up due date. Family Child Care providers will be available to provide care if the Child Development program cannot accommodate you due to not meeting the 8 total sign up requirement.

Snacks will be provided at the Child Development Center at no additional charge along with the following formulas: Enfamil w/ Iron, Enfamil Lacto-Free and Isomil Soy Formula. If your child requires formula not listed above, you will need to provide their formula.

If your child has attended the CDC during the day, ensure at least two hours between signing out of the center and signing into GPAB.
